

## **CAP Directors Report**

*July 2019*

### **Adult Athletics**

Pilates and Jazzercise continue to run successfully throughout the summer. CAP is pleased to be expanding the Yoga program and classes will be held at the Cambridge Market Café in the fall. Tuesday classes will be located in their upstairs space while Thursday classes will remain at the pool.

### **Aquatics**

26 members renewed or purchased passes/memberships in the month of July. Pool locker room stalls were replaced in July and look great! Private swim lessons continue to be very popular during the summer. Kathryn is diligently working on coordinating the pool updates to which we hope to have begin at the end of August.

### **CAP CARE**

Day Camp is nearly over and Cap Care is preparing for the fall. The field trips in July included the Retzer Center Planetarium, Jefferson County Fair, UW Space Place, and Safari Lake Geneva. The kids really enjoyed the Planetarium; many had never seen something like that before. For the first time Day Camp ventured to the Jefferson County Fair on kids free day. While there, day camp received many compliments from other patrons about how well behaved our groups were. The favorite of the summer thus far has been the Safari Lake Geneva trip. Kids got to ride a wagon to feed and pet many different animals, including buffalo!

The 2-4 graders have also enjoyed going to the Youth Center on Wednesday afternoons. Many of them are now excited to be attending the Youth Center in the future. Tuesdays have also been a huge hit as it is now biking day for everyone. Many children bring their bikes from home or share the ones we received from a grant from the Cambridge Foundation.

Miss Jen completed her Childcare course and will soon be a Co-Teacher.

Currently 13 students are on the waiting list for before and after school and 2 for the 4K program. Due to 10 children from the 2018-2019 school year going into 5<sup>th</sup> grade, Cap Care was able to take 10 children off our waiting list.

### **Community Café**

The Community Cafe was hosted by Willerup Methodist Church in July and served 205 individuals turkey, mashed potatoes, veggies, salad and dessert.

### **Food Pantry**

The Food Pantry served 138 households to which included 251 adults and 101 children in the month of July.

### **Ripley Park**

July was a very busy time at the park as the average attendance almost tripled from June. The weather was nicer and the fourth of July weekend was very busy. The shelters were once again reserved for a majority of the weekends. Ripley park also hosted the Lake Ripley Ride on July 27. There were 348 riders plus their families that came through the park that day.

### **Seniors**

The first meal was on July 10 and served 18 seniors Philly steak sandwiches while they watched a

preview of the Mary Poppins CD Players play. On July 24, 20 seniors enjoyed lasagna, salad and a roll and dessert. Mike Hanson from Jefferson County told seniors of ride services and of a program to go to different parks monthly and take walks. Rides would be provided for whomever would like to go on walk and check out parks in area.

### **Youth Athletics**

CAP finished up our Little League and Softball programs in July, and there was a great turn out for the ESYBL end of season tournament games. Great feedback from the parents and coaches was collected and will be used to improve for next year.

### **Youth Center**

The Youth Center is closed for the summer. Jordan is looking for a few additional staff members for the fall and has been planning for the new fundraisers in 2019-2020.

### **Youth Enrichment**

Art & Play (preschool program) was full for both sessions in July. Marketing for First Friends will be starting soon with hopes to fill the Tuesday/Thursday class times.

### **Other Information**

The Lake Ripley Ride was on Saturday, July 27. The event was very successful because of the amazing volunteers and participants. The ride had a record breaking year with 348 participants. Planning for the Try Cambridge Tri is in full swing with the event coming up on Sunday, August 18.
