Breakfast with Santa served just over 500 people which is 100 people more than last year. The Youth Center Dream Big renovations have started with Flores Painting donating the labor for the painting of the Youth Center. Lesli was also excited to report that as of the end of November, individuals have participated in a CAP program 77,000 times this year! Lastly, Nancy Brattlie will be presenting the Food Pantry program review next month.
